Savor the Moments

Close your eyes and picture a coastal Florida restaurant—what would it be? A table facing the ocean, with just-caught seafood and an ice-cold craft beer? You can certainly make that vision a reality in New Smyrna Beach. But the city is home to some culinary surprises as well: a cool speakeasy serving artisanal cocktails; some game-changing BBQ; and mouthwatering vegetarian dishes. But while the breadth of offerings may surprise you, the focus on culinary craftsmanship—beginning with local, seasonal, and sustainable ingredients—is something you'll come to expect. So bring your appetite on this foodie adventure: If you can imagine it, you can likely find it here.



Tipping the Scale

One area chef is on the front lines of a battle for more sustainable fishing. Winning has never tasted so delicious.

Food in New Smyrna Beach is definitely about passion, but it's also about focusing on protecting our natural resources. That means sourcing ingredients locally when possible and ensuring that animals have been humanely raised or fished.

This has also become a priority nationally. One example: the "Smart Catch" sustainable seafood program, run by the renowned James Beard Foundation, which trains chefs on how to serve seafood that's been farmed or fished in environmentally responsible ways. With more than 90 percent of the world's fisheries either fully fished or overfished, a growing number of U.S. chefs are recognizing the importance of such practices.

That importance is why Third Wave Cafe, under the direction of Executive Chef David Moscoso, has jumped the necessary hurdles to reel in its designation as an official James Beard Foundation Smart Catch Leader restaurant. Moscoso and others know that preserving the fish of tomorrow means taking bold steps today to marry great flavors with eco-friendliness.

Recipes

FLORIDA YELLOW SNAPPER

Ingredients:

- 1 oz olive oil blend
- 6-7 oz Florida
- Yellow Snapper

Directions:

Set stove to a medium-high flame. Add olive oil to an 8- to 10-inch sauté pan. Once oil is hot, place fish in the pan. Cook until done—typically to 3 to 4 minutes on each side, depending on thickness.

HERBED ROCK SHRIMP WITH LEMON BUTTER SAUCE

Ingredients:

• 1 oz spring onion or scallions

- 1 tbsp fresh chopped parsley
- 1 oz olive oil
- 1 pinch of pepper flakes
- 1 oz honey
- 2 oz small rock shrimp
- 1 tbsp minced garlic
- 1 tbsp butter

Directions:

Heat an 8- to 10-inch sauté pan on a medium to mediumhigh flame. Once the pan is heated, add olive oil. When the oil is hot, add garlic and pepper flakes and sauté both for about a minute. Add rock shrimp and sauté for about another minute. Shrimp cooks very fast, so be careful not to overcook. In the same pan, add the parsley and scallions. Finish

sautéing them until well blended—about another minute—then turn off the flame. Remove pan from heat; immediately add butter and honey. Stir butter and honey into sauce using a fork or tongs.

Start this delicious discovery process at the New Smyrna Beach Brewing Company, where specialty ales are brewed on-site; enjoy their signature IPA or try an Old Fort—a stout brewed with local, organic coffee.

Wine aficionado? You'll find fine wines across the area—and you don't have to just sit while sipping. Take part in the Flagler Avenue Wine Walk and the Art Walk, held on the fourth Saturday of each month, and experience the bustling

downtown area while sampling 100-plus unique wines. Beer enthusiasts can hit the Craft Beer Walk and the Art Stroll and Gallery Walk, held in the Canal Street Historic Arts District on the first Saturday of each month.

And if you prefer something stronger, you're also in luck. Head to the brand-new Sugar Works Distillery, which is bringing the art of handcrafted premium spirits to New Smyrna Beach.

Ingredients:

- 2 oz London dry gin
- 1 oz heavy cream
- 1 egg white from a freshly cracked egg
- 1 oz homemade simple syrup
- $\frac{1}{2}$ oz fresh-squeezed lime juice
- ¹/₂ oz fresh-squeezed lemon juice
- 4 dashes orange blossom flower water
- Splash of soda
